Safety21 acquires a minority stake in CASV to expand its presence in Spain and strengthen its European enforcement and smart mobility platform

Milan / Barcelona, June 30, 2026 – Safety21 S.p.A. ("Safety21" or the "Group"), Italy's leading provider of enforcement technologies, smart mobility solutions and digital road safety services, today announced the acquisition of a minority stake in CASV, a provider of technology-enabled enforcement services for local authorities and law enforcement agencies. The investment marks another important step in Safety21's international expansion strategy and further strengthens the Group's presence in the Iberian market, reinforcing its ambition to build a leading European platform in the enforcement sector.

CASV supports municipalities and public authorities across Spain with technology-enabled traffic enforcement services, specializing in the validation, processing and collection of traffic fines, particularly for speed enforcement. The company is a Barcelona-based subsidiary of the CGI Group, founded in 1998. The transaction has been completed through an agreement with CGI, CASV's majority shareholder and a leading player in the sector for more than twenty years. The agreement also includes an option allowing Safety21 to increase its shareholding to a majority stake, reflecting the parties' shared industrial vision and long-term partnership approach.

Following the transaction, CASV will continue to operate under its current management. It will be rebranded as CGI21 and gain access to the Group's technology, resources and industrial platform. The partnership is expected to accelerate the development of new solutions, expand the offering to customers and support additional growth opportunities across the European smart mobility market.

Gianluca Longo, Chief Executive Officer of Safety21, said:

"This transaction is fully aligned with our strategy of building a leading European group capable of driving innovation in enforcement and smart mobility through proprietary technologies, operational excellence and a strong local presence in key markets. CGI is a high-quality partner with distinctive capabilities, long-standing customer relationships and an outstanding management team. By joining forces, we believe we can accelerate the growth of both organizations while creating new opportunities for customers, partners and public institutions. The option to increase our shareholding reflects our confidence in the shared industrial project and our ambition to build an increasingly integrated European platform."
